Nut Free School

The Governing Body have opted for the school to become a "nut free" environment because we have several children in school who suffer from a severe nut allergy. Those children, if they come in contact with a nut product, can suffer life threatening consequences. A child with a nut allergy does not have to eat nuts themselves to react it sometimes only needs to be a touch from someone who has eaten them for them to react. This means that the following items cannot be bought into school:

Packs of nuts/any nuts -Peanut butter sandwiches -Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts -Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts -Sesame seed rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame)-Cakes made with nuts -Nutella

Please help us in providing a nut free school, minimising the risk for children as much as possible and assisting those parents who have children who may have a life threatening reaction.
