In the event of too many children arriving (not pre booked) for Breakfast Club we may have to turn you away due to staffing ratios, but in an emergency we are able to add children to the registers if needed.

Nut Free School

Reminder: The Governing Body opted for the school to become a “**nut free**” environment because we have several children in school who suffer from a severe nut allergy. Those children, if they come in contact with a nut product, can suffer life threatening consequences. A child with a nut allergy does not have to eat nuts themselves to react it sometimes only needs to be a touch from someone who has eaten them for them to react. This means that the following items cannot be bought into school in cakes or snacks:

Packs of nuts/any nuts -Peanut butter sandwiches

Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts -Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts –

Sesame seeds - rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame) –

Cakes made with nuts or ground nuts –Nutella

Please help us in providing a nut free school, minimising the risk for children as much as possible and assisting those parents who have children who may have a life threatening reaction.

Swimming Lessons

As part of the PE curriculum, swimming lessons have once again been planned for all KS2 children in the Summer Term 2017. A separate letter with the details was sent out last week and a duplicate of this letter is attached for any parents/carers who have not yet returned the slip. I am delighted to tell you that the cost has significantly reduced this year to just £10 for the 4 sessions. Although the payment is voluntary **we do seek full payment from all parents** as there are no other funds in school to support this activity. Unfortunately we may need to cancel the activity if all parents do not pay in full. If we are able to proceed with the lessons then parents will shortly be able to pay via parentpay.

PE Kits

Unfortunately some children do not have PE kits in school. It is important that kits are kept in school during the week; firstly for use in PE and secondly as a spare set of clothes if needed. Next week Mrs Churchill and Mr Bulbeck will be issuing letters to those children who do not have the correct kit in school. Please provide the correct kit for your child which should be: black shorts, white t shirt and trainers. All items belonging to your child should also be named clearly.
