The girls entered the competition as strong favourites to qualify through to the full county competition having finished runners up in the county for the previous 2 years, in the group stages we drew the first game despite dominating and won the next two games without conceding a goal. In the semi-final we played King Ina and produced a very good performance to win comfortably and book our place in the county final competition, the final of this stage saw us play Preston which has become something of a grudge match for them as we've knocked them out in the semi-finals of the county stage in the 2 previous seasons, they were certainly more focused and keen to beat us, where we were happy to rotate our team and use this as an opportunity to watch them and formulate plans to overcome them if we were to meet again in the county finals in January. The final score of 3-0 was a disappointing score line but one that in truth none of us were bothered about as we'd achieved what we set out to do in qualifying to the county finals. Very well played to both groups, another fantastic achievement for Tatworth School.
