

PE and Sports Premium Funding

At Tatworth Primary we want pupils physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.

We believe that the P.E. curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of the children. Through sport, the children begin to develop the important qualities of discipline, resilience, communication, team work and ambition; qualities that they are then able to use in their learning within the classroom as well as in wider life outside school.

The PE and Sports Funding will help our school to achieve self-sustaining improvement in the quality of PE and sport in primary schools.

Schools receive PE and Sport Premium funding based on the number of pupils in Years 1 to 6. In most cases, the amount received is determined by how many pupils at the Academy attract the funding.

Schools must spend the funding to improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offer their pupils but they are free to choose the best way of using the money.

For example, you can use your funding to:

- hire specialist PE teachers
- hire qualified sports coaches to work with teachers
- provide existing staff with teaching resources to help them teach PE and sport
- support and involve the least active children by running or extending school sports clubs
- run sport competitions or increase pupils' participation in the School Games
- run sports activities with other schools
