KS1 Sats

Sats have now finished for KS1, well done to Y2 for trying their best, we are very proud of them.

Sports Day

As you know we postponed Sports Day until next week on Thursday 25th May. The forecast is looking more positive and we hope it will go ahead that day. Please can the children arrive at school changed in their pe kits ready for Sports Day. Children will be taking part in traditional races such as wheel barrow races and piggy back races. These will be well supervised by adults but have an element of risk, so we ask that parents let us know if they do not want their children to take part. We will use face paints on children who would like them; but would love to see the children with their house colours represented with ribbons in their hair or a t shirt, socks etc. The house colours are: Joslin - red, Langdon - green, Brewer- Blue & Stonham – yellow. **We are asking all spectators to come through the main gate at the front of the school. These gates will not be open until 10.20am.** Once through the gate spectators are to please turn left and walk past the classrooms and the bottom playground and make their way to the school field. KS2 starts at 10.30 until 1pm and KS 1 starts at 2.10 until 3.15. Please make sure the children have sun cream, sun hats, drinks and up to date medication with them. Parents & carers are requested to bring their muscles for the tug of war!
