Changes to Data Protection Law

You may be aware that from May, the rules around data protection are changing. The 'General Data Protection Regulation' (GDPR) will change how we can use your personal data and keep it safe, and will also strengthen your rights over your own data.

The point of this is to make sure sensitive or private information about yourselves and your children stays safe. We have always treated your personal data with utmost care and will continue to do so. Whilst the new regulation is similar to the current Data Protection Act in many ways, there are a few differences, so we need to make a few changes at the school in order to ensure we remain compliant. These include updating our privacy notices and re-seeking your consent for the use of images. **A letter and form, regarding this is attached with a paper copy also being sent home and we need everyone to take the time to complete and return this to school as soon as possible.**
